Northern Ireland's website of services for homeless



Homeless Northern Ireland is a website that helps homeless people and those at risk of homelessness to get the services they need. It gives up to date information about 400 hostels, advice and support services.

### What does it do?

You can search online to get full details from the website about each service to compare different options available and their appropriateness. It gives information about advice services, hostels and supported housing projects, Housing Executive offices, floating support, CABx, Jobcentres and other services for the public and particular client groups.

Homeless Northern Ireland gives details of who each service is for, how to contact and make referrals, opening hours and support provided. For hostels, it also includes information such as length of stay, facilities and move-on accommodation.

Key features include:

- Easy-to-use but sophisticated search facilities
- Location maps for services with an office open to the public
- Access to information about services in other parts of the UK and Ireland
- Local information pages and frequently asked questions
- Links to websites and publications on Homelessness

### Who is it for?

- Agencies and advisors in contact with homeless people
- Homeless people, those in housing need or at risk of homelessness
- Policy makers, planners and researchers

### How can I use Homeless Northern Ireland?

To get started, simply visit the site and click on *Search all services* under the *Find a Service* menu.

You can use Homeless Northern Ireland without registering as an individual user, but if you do register (click on *My account* to do this), you can also:

- save your frequently used searches
- add your own additional information about agencies as user notes
- bookmark pages that you frequently refer to

### What difference will it make?

By signposting services, Homeless Northern Ireland will help improve the lives of homeless people. Benefits include:

- improved referrals and access to helping services
- preventing homelessness by giving information at an early stage
- sharing knowledge about homelessness services, issues and good practice
- aiding the planning process by giving a picture of supply of current services

### Who publishes Homeless NI?

The website is researched and published by Homeless Link, in partnership with Council for the Homeless Northern Ireland.

Homeless Link ([www.homeless.org.uk/](http://www.homeless.org.uk/)) is the sole national charity supporting people and organisations working directly with homeless people in England. Homeless Link represent homelessness organisations among local, regional and national government.
