## How can I use Homeless Northern Ireland?

To get started, simply visit the site and click on **Search all services** under the **Find a Service** menu.

You can enter text, e.g. Service name, or you can search by service, person or area, using the drop-down menus.

To search accommodation only, click on **Accommodation search** under the **Find a Service** menu.

This search facility is also easy to use & powerful, allowing you to search text, and by accommodation type, client group or area. There is also an advanced accommodation search.
