

Note re. tables: +/- change (n) refers to the increase / decrease in actual numbers when comparing the period 2005-2006 against 2004-2005. % change refers to the percentage increase or decrease. Where an entry is a minus value, this indicates a percentage or numerical decrease. Values without a minus sign indicate an increase. Some data will not tally with yearly totals of presenters, because decisions can be made to presenters who originally presented the previous year.
